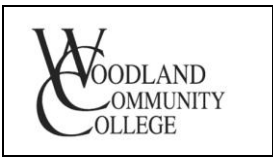
Woodland Community College (WCC), accredited in 2008 as the 110th California Community College, provides educational opportunities for resident in Yolo and outlying counties. The main campus is located in Woodland, CA and occupies 120 acres with six buildings totaling 140,000 assignable square feet, and continues to grow. The newest addition, Colusa County Outreach Facility (CCOF) in Williams, opened its doors to students in spring 2011. In addition to transfer programs, WCC offers distributive education (DE), remedial courses, career education and other life-long learning opportunities. Students have access to an array of support services, dedicated staff, and a child development center.

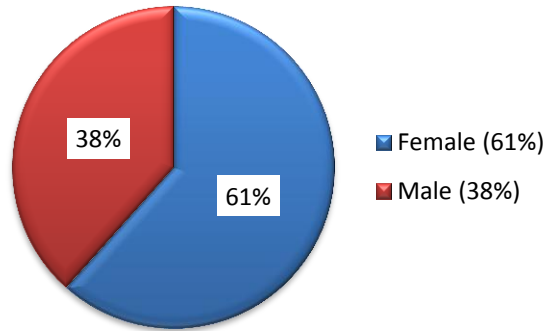

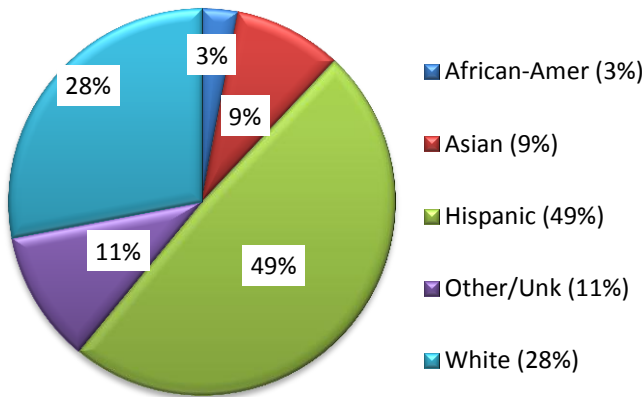

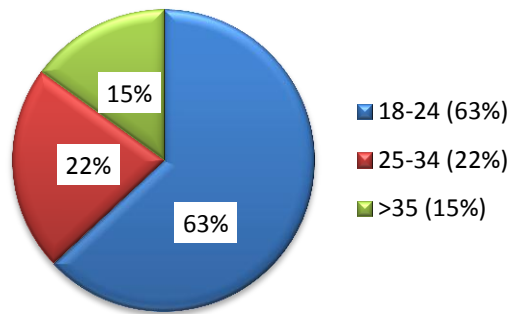
WCC Student Gender (Fall 2013)
